## *The Art of Neuroscience*

The OHSU Brain Institute (OBI) is excited to announce the opening of the first annual Art of Neuroscience competition. We are delighted to have a dedicated high school category, dedicated to entries from area high school students. Prizes will be awarded at the OBI Annual Forum on Friday, November 18, at OHSU. First Prize in the high school category will include a cash award.

High school students are invited to create artwork that broadly explores the aesthetics of brain and mind.

### Competition Information and Guidelines - High School Category

Accepted Media: Drawing, painting, or print on paper, canvas, wood, etc.  
Sculpture: paper, ceramic, metal, plastic, wood, etc.  
(No electricity, no batteries, nothing inherently dangerous or toxic)

Maximum size: Drawing, painting, print, etc.: 24"x36"  
3D sculpture: 24"x24"x36"  
Maximum weight for any entry is 25 lbs.

Please include with your entry:

1. Artist's name, high school attending, contact information
2. Description of artwork, 100 words or fewer (media, title of artwork, brief statement on what is depicted and why artist chose the subject)
3. Electronic image of the artwork: 1 JPEG image file for 2D submissions, such as drawing, painting or print  
Up to 4 JPEG image files for 3D sculptures, to capture different views

All entries will be juried by Review Panel

Selected entries will be invited to display artwork at the Forum, Friday, November 18, 2016

Review Panel reserves the right to reject any entry for display or award

Decisions by Review Panel are final

Review Panel will notify artists by email of selection decisions by Tues, November 8, 2016, and will include information on how to display selected artwork at the Forum at OHSU. The First Prize high school winner will be invited to attend the Annual Forum with his or her art teacher and family.
