BEHN 650: Teaching Practicum

Two, two week sessions, winter term, four slots...

- Are you curious about teaching? Want to work with undergraduates at PSU, the most diverse public university in Oregon? Improve your speaking & presentation skills, & make your research accessible? Are you excited about engaging, inspiring & genuinely connecting with students as a role model & mentor? Are you interested in gaining experience that might help you land a job after your defense..?
- Behavioral Neuroscience offers a Teaching Practicum course (BEHN 650) in winter term, which provides short (two week) opportunities <u>for post-quals graduate</u> <u>students with mentor permission</u> to prepare and deliver lectures on your own lab work & current topics in neuroscience research (e.g., drug abuse/dependence, learning & memory, adolescent brain development, neurodegeneration,...), lead discussions, organize online course materials, & develop/score assessments.




- Academic priority K-12, urban/rural communities, tribal majority schools
 - Not always well-funded, or valued, often ignored, subjected to standardized testing that primarily benefits others.
 Complex brain development underway, unacknowledged diversity, mental health...
- Homeless youth (p:ear), incarcerated youth (MacLaren Correctional Facility)
 - "It's like people see me as an object, not as a human being"
- Young graduate researchers, undergraduates (PSU, OHSU,...)
 - How does my research relate to the world? How can I explain it?
 - Where can I go from here? "Alternative careers" in science...
- Artists: Painters, Dancers, Storytellers, Musicians
 - How does my work relate to other fields? How do I connect with new audiences?
 - How is my practice influenced and enriched by discoveries about the brain?
- Area businesses (BioGift, Intel, Velo Cult, Hospitals)
 - How can we better connect with everyone in our community?
- Members of the public
 - Why are my taxes spent on research? Art? What are we discovering? Making?




