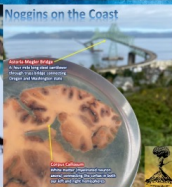
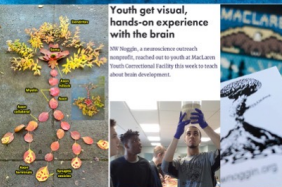

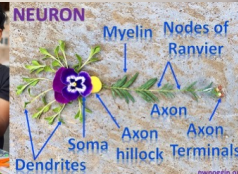

Audition (Hearing!)

Something moves or vibrates, generating pressure changes in the air that travel outwards from their source. These waves of pressure changes are **SOUND WAVES**, and we have special sensory neurons that can respond!
